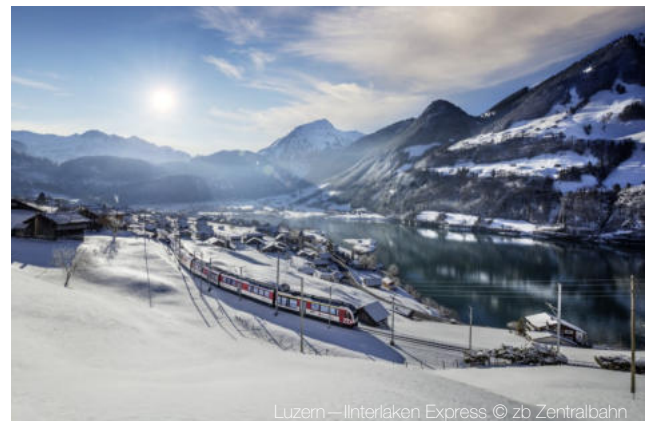
HOW TO GET TO LUCERNE

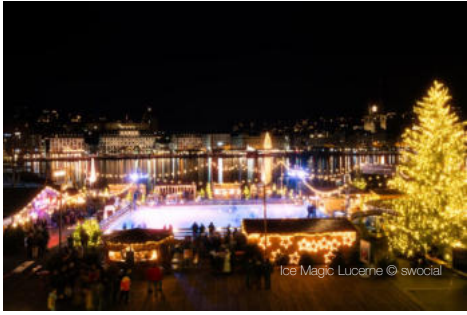

LILU LIGHT FESTIVAL LUCERNE

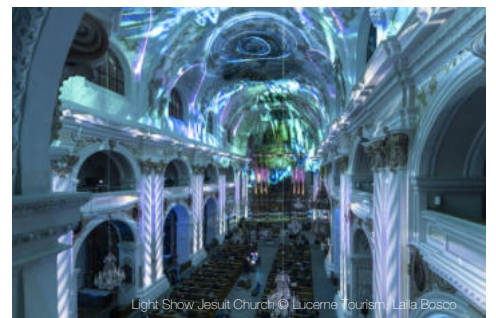

The Water Tower, buildings, churches and alleys in the city center of Lucerne are lighten up in wonderful bright colors. CARNIVAL IN LUCERNE

During Carnival, Lucerne's Old Town is transformed into one big festival site. People celebrate, make and enjoy music, and dance. A loud explosion (the Urknall or «Big Bang») at five in the morning of Schmutzig Thursday marks the official start of the Lucerne Carnival. All is quiet again the following Ash Wednesday, which is forty days before Palm Sunday. The carnival is the largest annual event held in the city of Lucerne.

Programme:

- Saturday, 30 January 2027
 - * Fasnachtsmäart (carnival market) starts at 11 am at Unter der Egg—this is a pre-carnival event
- Tuesday, 2 February 2027
 - * Usgüüglete (carnival announcement) starts at 3pm at Unter der Egg
- Thursday, 4 February 2027
 - * Big Bang at 5am at Kapellplatz—official start
 - * First parade at 1.45pm. through the city centre
- Monday, 8 February 2027
 - * Final parade at 1.45pm. through the city centre
- Tuesday, 9 February 2027
 - * Monstercorso parade (music performances) at 19.30 hrs. at Bahnhofstrasse
- 4 / 6 / 8 / 9 February 2027:
 - * Party in the streets, masked people and a lot of bars, drinks and fun
